## INTRODUCTION

Genealogists can be proud that Mr. Raymond Clark, and his mother, Sara Seth Clark, have decided to publish another volume of scarce or hard-to-locate Maryland source records (to complement their Queen Anne's Co., Md., Marriage Licenses, 1817-1848). With the greater interest in Maryland history and Maryland genealogy the publishing of such books is a great service.

This is the earliest record of Baltimore County in existence. This tax list, from 1699-1706, in manuscript form, was purchased in a small book by the Maryland Historical Society early in this century. Because of its fragile condition and great age it was necessary to have the manuscript repaired or "silked" which has made parts of it very very hard to read. Some years ago an elderly member of our Society made a typed copy of this tax list and presented it to us. However, Mr. and Mrs. Clark's compilation makes the list available to a much wider audience or public than those users of our Society's Library.

Tax lists rank as an important genealogical tool, along with wills, deeds, marriage licenses, census schedules and tombstone inscriptions. The faithful copying of this list by two competent historians and genealogists will be greatly appreciated by scholars and laymen interested in these two fields, and more particularly those interested in Maryland research. An extra feature of the volume is the full-name index and a map of the county as it was when it was created and at the time of this list.

## PREFACE

The tax list for each year is arranged according to the local sub-divisions of the county, called "hundreds." In using this list the readers need to understand the principles used by the compilers in assembling this listing. A general rule used throughout was that the names were copied as they were written. No attempt was made to connect rather obvious variations under the more common name because positive proof of a relationship was lacking.

In a few instances the commoner form is listed first with the variations in parentheses: Jo(a)ns; or Lawrence (Larurence, Lar.). In a few cases where a final decision on an entry was still in doubt the compilers had two alternatives: (1) use the suggested form first and place the alternate form in parenthesis immediately after it, or (2) use one form and use a "See reference" to the other: e.g. Guage. See Bauge.

On abbreviations of Christian names we were reluctant to assume that "Jno." meant "John" over say, "Jonathan." Or that "Ja." always meant "James." It was more obvious that Richd. Wm. or Will, Geo., Mich<sup>l</sup> and Nich. meant Richard, George, William, Michael and Nicholas. The compilers did take the liberty of listing all unidentified persons first before the alphabetical listings of those of the same name: thus all "Mr., Mrs., Capt., Col." appear before Abraham to Zachary Smith. We also listed all widows as "Mrs." The final 's' was taken from those names of persons that were cited as living with someone or at some place.

The compilers feel that the many many hours spent in copying, deciphering, rechecking, arranging, editing and indexing of this early but important tax list will be worth the trouble, and therefore take pleasure in presenting it and publishing it.

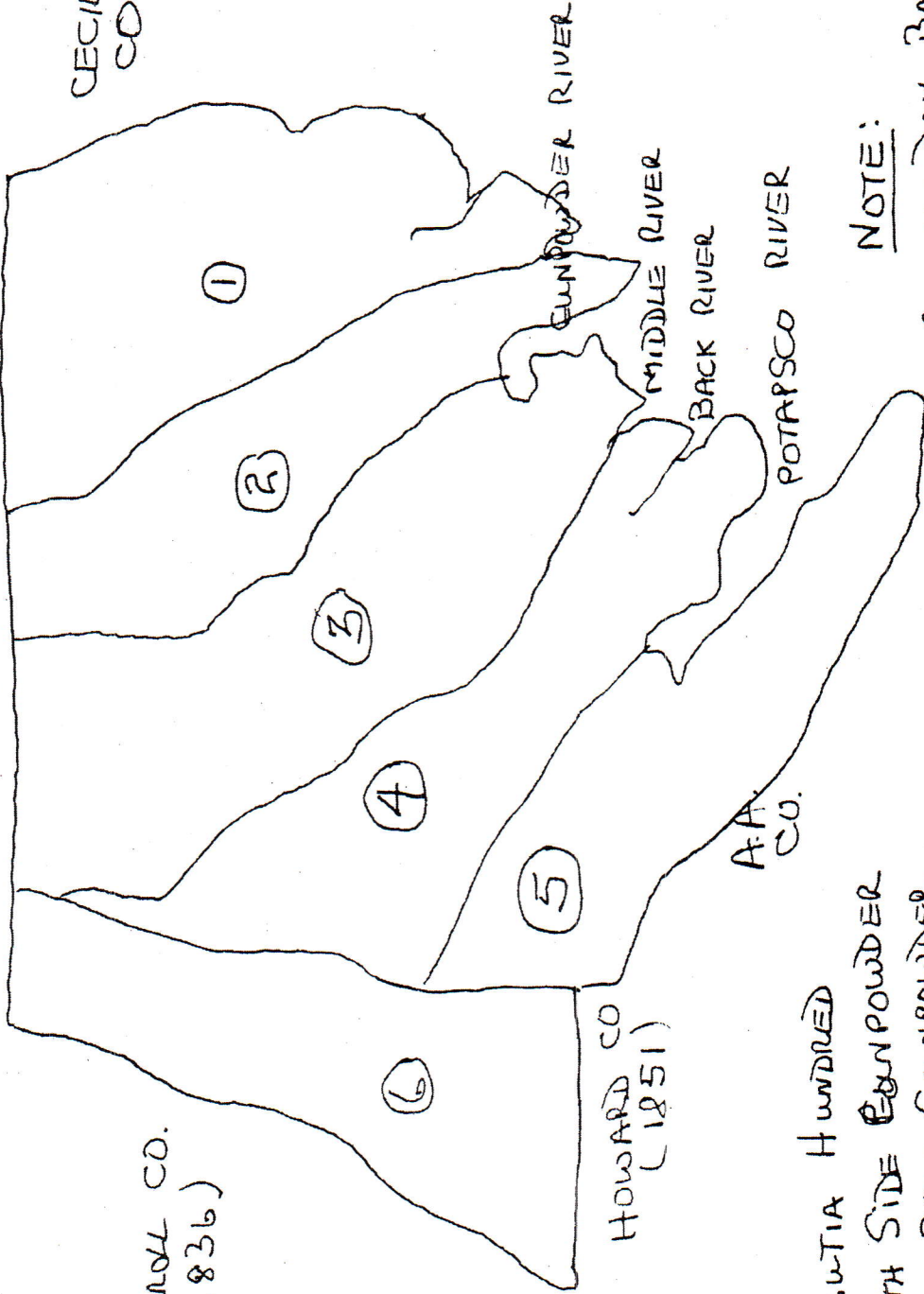
