Be it Remembered That heretofore to wit on the twelfth day of July  
in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty five came  
John Logsdon, Ralph Logsdon, Joseph Ellis [Joseph] Ellis and wife and  
Edward Logsdon by Bean L. Pigman Esquire their Solicitor into the Court  
of Chancery of Maryland and exhibited in the said Court their Bill of  
Complaint against Jeremiah Blubaugh, Mary Logue, James Logue, George  
Payne and others in the words following.

To the Honorable the Chancellor of Maryland.

Humbly complaining, John Logsdon, Ralph Logsdon, Joseph Ellis, and Oner  
Ellis, his wife and Edward Logsdon beg leave to represent that on the  
first-day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight  
[seven] hundred and forty three Charles Carroll Esquire obtained out of  
the Land office of Maryland for the western shore a patent for a tract  
of land lying and being in Frederick County called **FANNETS MEADOW**,  
containing one hundred acres of Land more or less, as appears by  
Exhibit A, which with all the other Exhibits now referred to in this  
bill, it is prayed may make a part of this complaint, your complainants  
state that soon after said patent issued to the said Charles Carroll  
Esquire be conveyed by proper legal grant the said tract of land called  
**FANNETS MEADOW** to a certain John Logsdon Senior of Frederick County  
Maryland, and some where about the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and fifty put the said John Logsdon Senior in full possession  
of the tract of land that the said John Logsdon Senior then a young man  
with a young family immediately began to clear the said land and build  
all necessary improvements thereon, and continued in full possession of  
said tract of land from the time he first took possession thereof until  
about the month of October in the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and ninety seven, about which last mentioned time the said John  
Logsdon Senior died in full possession of said land. that the said John  
Logsdon Senior died at Frederick County aforesaid intestate, leaving at  
the time of his death the following named children his only heirs at  
law to wit: [1] Ralph Logsdon, John Logsdon, Prudence Logsdon, William  
Logsdon, Oner Ellis the wife of Joseph Ellis and Eleanor [Edward]  
Logsdon. That the said John Logsdon Senior being seized in fee simple

That the said John Logsdon Senior being seized in fee simple of said land after his death it descended to his said children and heirs at law, under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Maryland, that Ralph Logsdon since the death of his father hath also departed this life intestate leaving the following persons his *only* children and heirs at law to wit: ] Anjemina Logsdon, Rachel Logsdon, Mary Logsdon and Margaret Logsdon, Oner Logsdon, Ann Logsdon, Sarah Logsdon, Mary Logsdon, said Anjemina Logsdon *intermarried* with John Blubaugh, that the John Blubaugh is since dead, and the said Anjemina Blubaugh now resides in the state of Pennsylvania, that Rachel Logsdon *intermarried* with George Payne, that the said Rachel and George are both dead intestate leaving the following persons



their only children and heirs at law to wit: ] Mary Payne intermarried with James Logue both now residing in the state of Ohio, John Payne who is also dead intestate leaving the following named persons his only children and heirs at law, George Payne, Rachel Payne, Ralph Payne and Jacob Payne residing in the state of Ohio, Susanna Payne since intermarried with Thomas Porter, the said Susanna Payne having since died intestate leaving her husband Thomas Porter and also the following persons her only children and heirs at law to wit: ] Mary Porter, George Porter, Michael Porter, Samuel Porter and Thomas Porter all residing with their said father in the state of Ohio. Ralph Payne residing the state of Ohio, Rachel Payne since intermarried with Elias Arnold now living with her said husband in the state of Ohio. Sarah Payne intermarried with Samuel Durbin, residing with her said husband in Allegany County Maryland. that Mary Logsdon daughter of the said Ralph Logsdon resides in Allegany County, that Margaret Logsdon daughter of the said Ralph Logsdon intermarried with George Sapp and now resides with her husband in the state of Ohio. that Daniel Logue daughter of the said Ralph Logsdon intermarried with Daniel Logue and now resides with her husband in the state of Ohio. That Anne Logsdon daughter of the said Ralph Logsdon intermarried with Johnny Arnold and now resides with her husband in Allegany County. that Sarah Logsdon daughter of said Ralph Logsdon intermarried with Richard Carter of Allegany County in which county she now resides with her husband. That John Logsdon son of the first named John Logsdon since the death of his father hath also died and by his last will and testament made in due form of law devised his estate in a tract of land called FANNEYS MEADOW, to two of your complainants to wit: ] John Logsdon and Ralph Logsdon as will appear by Exhibit B, that Prudence Logsdon since the death of the said John Logsdon Senior hath also departed this life, and by her last will and testament made in due form of law devised all her estate in the land called FANNEYS MEADOW to John Logsdon of Prudence as appears by Exhibit C. That Robert Logsdon since the death of the said John Logsdon Senior hath also departed this life after making his last will and testament in due form of law by which he devised all his part of said Estate to John Logsdon of Prudence who is hereafter mentioned as appears by Exhibit D. That Margaret Logsdon since the death of the said John Logsdon Senior hath also departed this life intestate and without issue leaving her brothers and sisters and their survivors



as appears by Exhibit D. That Margaret Logsdon since the death of the said John Logsdon Senior hath also departed this life intestate and without issue leaving her brothers and sisters and their surviving descendants who are all made parties to this bill her heirs at law.

That William Logsdon since the death of the said John Logsdon Senior hath also departed this life intestate leaving a widow Margaret Logsdor and the following persons his only children and heirs to wit: John Logsdon, one of your complainants, Ralph Logsdon, also one of your complainants, also Mary Logsdon, William Logsdon, Margaret Logsdon, Joseph Logsdon, David Logsdon the survivors, now residing in Knox County state of Ohio, and John Logsdon residing in Allegany County Maryland. That Mary Logsdon daughter of the said William Logsdon son of John Logsdon Senior intermarried with Thomas Porter that the said Mary


