Raphael "Ralph" was the son of John Lawrence Logsdon (b.1716, d.1797) and Margaret Wooley (b.1717, d.1781).

His occupation was "Soldier" and farmer. He served in the French and Indian War from 1756 to 1763. Some suggest he also served in the Revolutionary War.

On 3 Apr 1767 in Loverland, (One Mile North), Waterford, Frederick Co., Maryland; he bought 128 acres from Andrew Bruce. By 1798 he had acquired several additional parcels of land per the local tax records.

During 1756 in Baltimore, Baltimore Co., Maryland he married his first cousin Mary C. Durbin (b.1Dec1739, d.17Apr1829).

Will: Raphael Logsdon, 1818: Allegany County, MD

In the name of God Amen, I Raphael Logsdon of Allegany County in the State of Maryland, being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say, First and principally, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named.

After my debts and funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows: Item, I give unto my nephew John Losdon my silver watch. Item, I give and bequeath unto Samuel Durbin

Item, I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal unto my dear wife Mary during her natural life and at her death, Item, I devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal to be equally divided among my six daughters Jemimiah, Mary, Margaret, Honnor, Nancy and Sarah to them. their heirs and assigns forever, in equal portion share and share alike.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint John Mattingly to be my sole Executor of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.--- In testimony whereof I have here unto Set my hand and affixed my seal this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and eighteen.---

Signed, sealed, published & declared by Raphael Logsdon, the above named Raphael Logsdon {seal} testator, as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us who at his request, in his presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses hereto.
